MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE of the BOARD OF TRUSTEES November 2, 1961

Present: Messrs. Harlan, Huff, Merriman, Smith, Stevens, Vanderploeg; President Hannah, Vice President May and Secretary Breslin

The Committee convened for dinner at 6 o'clock at Kellogg Center and following dinner the Finance Committee meeting was held.

1. Vice President May presented a tentative appropriation request for submission to the Governor and State Department of Administration. The details of the items involved were reviewed at some length. In summary, it was recommended that the Board authorize the following requests:
