The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

On motion of Mr. Doherty, President Snyder was instructed to request the War Department to appoint a Commandant for the Military Department of the College, to succeed Captain Fuger, whose appointment has expired.

On motion of Judge Carpenter, the following resolution was adopted:-

RESOLVED, That the city of East Lansing be given a license to dispose of the overflow from their septic tanks through the college sewer system. This license may be terminated by the Board at any time on a year's notice, and in no event to extend beyond five years. It is given upon the condition that the capacity of the septic tanks, now used by the City, will be so increased as to take care of all the sewerage, and also, that all roof drains be disconnected with the sewerage system. Also, that all expense incurred in making this improvement shall be borne by the City and that that part of the sewer laid on the college ground shall be constructed by the college at the expense of the City, and subject at all times to the control of the State Board of Agriculture.
