BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Michigan State University operates under the jurisdiction of a constitutional body known as the Board of Trustees. The eight elected members serve eight-year terms. Two are elected biennially from the state at large.

The Board has general supervision of the University and the control and direction of all expenditures of University funds.

ACADEMIC COSTUME

The pageantry and color at commencement exercises reveal a record of academic achievement of the various individuals taking part in the exercises. The following brief description is given so that the audience may more readily interpret such achievement.

In 1895, the Intercollegiate Commission, a group of leading American educators, met at Columbia University to draft a code which would serve to regulate the design of gowns and hoods indicating the various degrees as well as the colors to indicate the various faculties. This code has been adopted by most of the colleges and universities in America and its use has made identification of scholastic honors an immediate activity.

Three types of gowns are indicated by the code. Those worn by the bachelors have long, pointed sleeves. Those worn by masters have long, closed sleeves with the arc of a circle near the bottom. Doctor's gowns are faced with velvet. The sleeves are full, round and open with three bars of velvet on each sleeve. The velvet facing of bars on the sleeves may be black or the same color as the binding of the hood.

Hoods are made of material identical with the gown and are lined in the official academic color of the institution conferring the degree. If the institution has more than one color, the chevron is used to introduce the second color. Colored velvet or velveteen binds the hoods and indicates the department or faculty to which the degree pertains.

Historical associations of color have been continued to signify the various faculties. Arts and letters can be recognized by the white, taken from the traditional white fur trimming of the Oxford and Cambridge Bachelor of Arts hoods. Red, long traditional of the church, indicates theology. The royal purple of the King's court signifies law. The green of medicinal herbs immediately identifies a medical degree. Philosophy is signified by the color of wisdom and truth, blue. Because through research untold wealth has been released to the world, science is identified by golden yellow. Oxford pink indicates music, and russet brown, the color of dress worn by ancient English foresters, indicates forestry.

The color of the velvet of the hood is distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture should be maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science.

At Michigan State University, it is customary to identify the candidates graduating from the different departments of study by tassels of the official department color as established by the Intercollegiate Code.

MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY

Michigan State University, one of the leading land-grant universities and the first agricultural college in America, strives for excellence in affording liberal and practical education for its students in a broad range of human endeavor.

MSU also serves people of the state, nation and world through its numerous research, extension and international programs.

Now in its 122nd year, Michigan State University has grown from three buildings and six faculty members to one of the largest universities in the nation. It has more than 3,400 faculty engaged in teaching, research and public service, 386 campus buildings, and more than 5,100 acres of land of which 2,010 acres are in existing or planned campus development.

Founded in 1855 to educate youth for the major occupation of that day — farming — MSU has broadened its offerings to meet the educational needs of today. The University now has a Graduate School and 17 colleges — Agriculture and Natural Resources, Arts and Letters, Business, Communication Arts and Sciences, Education, Engineering, Human Ecology, Human Medicine, James Madison, Justin S. Morrill, Lyman J. Briggs, Natural Science, Osteopathic Medicine, Social Science, University College, Urban Development, and Veterinary Medicine. Some 200 programs of instruction are available to undergraduates; 76 departments offer graduate studies.

MSU is unique nationally in that the Colleges of Human Medicine, Osteopathic Medicine, and Veterinary Medicine are located on the single campus.

The Honors College, which enables superior undergraduate students to waive normal graduation requirements and undertake individual programs, attracts many of the nation's finest young scholars. Michigan State University also is a prominent sponsor of the National Merit Scholarship Program, comprised of an unusually select group of scholars.

One of the many innovations in higher education made by Michigan State University is its system of academic-residence halls. Incorporation of classrooms and faculty offices with living, dining and recreational facilities has given these giant dormitories a stimulating academic environment. Each of these nine halls is the center of curricular and noncurricular activities, creating a "college within a college" atmosphere.

The "small college within the larger university" concept was introduced at MSU by the establishment of the Justin S. Morrill College, which offers a limited enrollment liberal education program with an international emphasis. The concept was expanded by the establishment and opening of the James Madison College and the Lyman J. Briggs College. James Madison offers a curriculum for the study of public policy problems within the framework of the social sciences and related disciplines. Lyman Briggs makes available a liberal curriculum for students especially interested in science and mathematics.

Today, almost 44,000 students attend the University at East Lansing. About 85 percent are from Michigan; the remainder includes more than 1,200 foreign students from 86 countries.

In the land-grant tradition it pioneered, Michigan State University is concerned with research and service as well as teaching. All colleges and the Agricultural Experiment Station are engaged in a wide range of research. Approximately 3,000 individual projects are in process. The University's research tools include the Control Data 6500 computer, a cyclotron of the sector-focused type capable of accelerating protons to 50 MeV (60,000 miles per second), and the MSU Observatory which houses a 24-inch reflecting telescope, a computer and related equipment. Facilities are acquired and continually adapted to strengthen the research capabilities of the University.

Through an agreement with the Energy Research Development Administration, MSU has become a national center for basic research on plants and their reactions to radiation; involved is a \$2 million building, a staff of approximately 90 persons and an annual budget of approximately \$1 million.

Benefits of the University are brought to every county in Michigan by the Cooperative Extension Service and the Continuing Education Service. Their programs, on and off campus, provide a wide range of technical information and formal course work for hundreds of thousands of Michigan citizens. The Kellogg Center for Continuing Education, one of the finest conference centers in the nation, annually hosts nearly 50,000 adults who come to the campus for some 600 conferences and other educational meetings.

In broadening the scope of educational opportunity, MSU is building on its long experience in continuing education to develop a Lifelong Education Program which will offer University resources to persons who are educationally or economically excluded from the traditional campus programs; to those who seek new skills or wish to update present skills; and to those who wish through education to make their leisure time more productive. The Program also will enable the University to cooperate with local communities in assessing, developing, and expanding their continuing education projects.

Michigan State University's land-grant concept of service is international. Supported by grants from the federal government and private foundations, Michigan State University maintains research and educational assistance projects on a world-wide basis. International projects have given many faculty members overseas experience, adding a new dimension to their teaching.

With more than a century of educational achievement behind it, Michigan State University continues to apply its academic and physical resources to the problems of today and the challenges of the future.

HONORARY DEGREES

ARCHIBALD COX

As the Samuel Williston Professor of Law at Harvard, you are probably best known nationally as the Watergate Special Prosecutor who set up and directed the special force to investigate misconduct in the executive offices of the President until you were dismissed in October, 1973 by former President Nixon. Your distinguished career includes many assignments that called upon your leadership and probity. You served three other Presidents: as Chairman of the Wage Stabilization Board under President Truman, and as Solicitor General of the United States under Presidents Kennedy and Johnson. In 1968, you chaired a commission to investigate disorders at Columbia University. Harvard University then delegated to you the authority to determine how it would respond to similar disorders, a responsibility you pursued through June 1971. Subsequently you became counsel for a special committee to investigate members of the Massachusetts judiciary. The appointment as Watergate Special Prosecutor followed the next year. In spite of this series of calls to serve the public in local, state and national affairs, you found the time to publish several influential books on the law. Because of your exceptional public service, in times requiring stewardship in regard to legal ethics, and your civic commitments to defend and protect those principles in the stressful arenas of contemporary society, Michigan State University is pleased to grant you the degree of Doctor of Laws.

MARTHA W. GRIFFITHS

Martha W. Griffiths, the Commencement speaker, received an honorary degree of Doctor of Laws from Michigan State University in 1966. An attorney and public servant of great distinction, Mrs. Griffiths represented the 17th Congressional District of Michigan in the U.S. House of Representatives from 1955 to 1975. There, she was a champion of equal opportunity measures, sponsoring the Equal Rights Amendment to the Constitution and guiding its passage through the House in the 91st Congress. Mrs. Griffiths received her law degree from the University of Michigan and was admitted to the Michigan bar in 1941. She first entered public life as a member of the Michigan Legislature from 1949 to 1952 and was a judge and recorder of the Detroit Recorder's Court in 1953, the first woman to hold that post. Mrs. Griffiths presently serves on boards of directors of the American Automobile Club of Michigan, Burroughs Corporation, Consumers Power Company, National Detroit Corporation and S.S. Kresge Company.

HONORARY DEGREES

ROLLO MAY

The titles of some of your best-known books display the wide range of your professional, philosophical and spiritual interests in modern cultural crises: "Art of Counseling," "The Meaning of Anxiety," "Man's Search for Himself," "Psychology and the Human Dilemma," "Love and Will," and most recently, "The Courage to Create." Your multiple careers as psychoanalyst, professor, administrator, consultant, writer and lecturer illustrate that you have gone beyond the conventional boundaries of profession or practice. You have been a visiting professor at several universities including Yale and Princeton; training analyst at the William Alanson White Institute of Psychiatry, Psychology and Psychoanalysis; co-chairman of the Conference on Psychotherapy and Counseling, New York Academy of Science; past president of the New York State Psychological Association; fellow of the National Council of Religion in Higher Education; and fellow of the American Psychological Association. Phi Beta Kappa awarded you the Ralph Waldo Emerson Award for your book "Love and Will." The American Psychological Association gave you an award for distinguished contribution to the Science and Profession of Clinical Psychology. The New York Society of Clinical Psychologists awarded you its special Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Award for your book "Power and Innocence," calling it a "penetrating study and search for the sources of violence in our society." Because of your outstanding contributions to our better understanding of the central problems of our times, Michigan State University is pleased to grant you the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters.

DONALD J. MORFEE

In the years since your graduation from Michigan State University in 1948 as a civil engineer, you have followed a noteworthy career in business. Your rise to corporate leadership began in the American Bridge Division of United States Steel. In 1965, you became President of Pullman Swindell, the Pittsburgh-based engineering and construction division of Pullman Incorporated. As President, you negotiated the first major contract with the Soviet Union on the Kama River Truck Plant in 1971. This plant is the largest of its type in the world. In 1973, you were promoted to Vice President of Pullman Incorporated in its Chicago world headquarters which includes responsibility for the Moscow and Warsaw offices of the corporation. You are a director of the Michigan Seamless Tube Company and of Pullman Torkelson Company while also Chairman of the Board of Pullman Berry Company. In spite of this heavy commitment to corporate leadership, you demonstrate concern for civic affairs as you serve on the Board of Directors of the Chicago Association of Commerce and Industry, on the National Board of Directors of Junior Achievement and its Chicago executive committee, and on the Board of Governors of International House of the University of Chicago. Because of your distinguished career in industry and your civic leadership, Michigan State University is pleased to grant you the degree of Doctor of Laws.

DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI AWARDS

CLARE F. JARECKI

Class of 1933. Administrator. Businessman. Industrialist. President and Chairman of the Board of Jarecki Corporation, Grand Rapids, Michigan. Born in Grand Rapids, he attended Ferris State University and Michigan State University. As President of Jarecki Corporation — at one time the largest tool and die operation in the world — Mr. Jarecki has been recognized internationally for numerous innovations in the use of plastic and metal products. Previously, he was President of North Shores Marina, Inc. of Grand Haven; Jarecki Products and Nichols & Cox Lumber Company, both of Grand Rapids. In 1963 he was named a Distinguished Alumnus of Ferris State University and in 1972 that University conferred upon him the Honorary Doctor of Laws Degree. Mr. Jarecki has been a long-time supporter of Michigan State University through the Presidents Club; also he is a former member and Chairman of the MSU Development Council. Additionally, he is a founder and current chairman of the MSU Foundation, established to enhance and promote the private fund-raising efforts of the University.

DR. K. N. SATYAPAL

Class of 1961. Agriculturalist. Educator. International Soils Expert. Principal Technical Advisor in the Technical Advisory Division of the United Nations Development Program. A native of India, Dr. Satyapal received the B.S. degree in chemistry from Poona University in 1950 and the B.S. degree with honors in botany in 1952. He received the M.S. degree in Soil Science from Michigan State University in 1956 and the Ph.D. in 1960. While attending Michigan State University, Dr. Satyapal developed an interest in the study of the Russian Language and he completed undergraduate requirements in that discipline to become the first MSU student to be awarded a degree in Russian. During his fifteen years with the United Nations, he has administered technical assistance and research projects in nearly fifty countries. Included among projects under his direction were improvements in the growing of cotton, maize, bananas, tobacco, citrus fruits and vegetable crops, eradication of the Mediterranean fruit fly, and the establishment of numerous soil fertility research units. Dr. Satyapal has been recognized throughout the world for his comprehensive understanding of the needs of developing countries based on his appreciation of the land-grant philosophy which he has utilized at the international level in dealing with solutions of the practical problems of agriculture.
