ACADEMIC COSTUME

In 1895, the Intercollegiate Commission, a group of leading American educators, introduced an academic costume code which by design of gowns and hoods would indicate the various degrees, and which by colors would identify the various faculties.

Three types of gowns are indicated by the code. Those worn by the bachelors have long, pointed sleeves. Those worn by masters have long, closed sleeves with the arc of a circle near the bottom. Doctor's gowns are faced with velvet. The sleeves are full, round, and open with three bars of velvet on each sleeve. The velvet facing of the bars on the sleeves may be black or the same color as the binding of the hood.

Hoods are made of material identical with the gown and are lined in the official academic color of the institution conferring the degree (e.g., green and white for MSU; burnt orange and white for the University of Texas; blue and gold for UCLA). If the institution has more than one color, the chevron is used to introduce the second color. Colored velvet or velveteen binds the hoods and indicates the department or faculty to which the degree pertains.

The color of the velvet of the hood is distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture should be maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. Generally, the code for the velvet of the hood is the same as listed below for tassels.

At Michigan State University, it is customary to identify the candidates graduating from the different departments of study by tassels of the official department color as established by the Intercollegiate Code.

MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY

Michigan State University, a leading land-grant university and the first agricultural college in America, strives for excellence in providing students a broad curricula of liberal and practical education. MSU also serves people of the state, nation, and world through its numerous research, extension, and international programs.

Now in its 134th year, Michigan State University has grown from three buildings and six faculty members to one of the largest universities in the nation. It has more than 3,000 faculty/staff engaged in teaching, research, and public service; more than 400 campus buildings; and more than 5,200 acres of land, of which some 2,100 acres are in existing or planned campus development. More than 42,000 students now attend the university at East Lansing, of which some 86 percent are from Michigan.

Founded in 1855 to educate youth for the major occupation of that day — farming — MSU has broadened its offerings to meet the educational needs of today. The university now has a Graduate School and 14 colleges — Agriculture and Natural Resources, Arts and Letters, Business, Communication Arts and Sciences, Education, Engineering, Human Ecology, Human Medicine, James Madison, Natural Science, Nursing, Osteopathic Medicine, Social Science, and Veterinary Medicine.

At the center of all major universities is a cluster of disciplines that constitute the liberal arts and sciences. At MSU, this center consists of three colleges — Arts and Letters, Natural Science, and Social Science. Providing outstanding undergraduate and graduate degree programs with majors in traditional disciplines, these colleges also have special programs that enable students to obtain a broad multidisciplinary education. In addition, in collaboration with the College of Education, the three colleges prepare students to become teachers in the secondary schools of Michigan and the nation. These colleges touch the lives of all undergraduate students at MSU by providing the general education that constitutes approximately one-quarter of the undergraduate program. The Honors College, which enables superior undergraduate students to waive normal graduation requirements and undertake individual programs, attracts many of the nation's finest young scholars. MSU is proud of its record in producing Rhodes Scholars, a total of thirteen (ten in the last sixteen years); the university also has provided six Marshall Scholarship winners. These British scholarships are two of the most distinguished and prestigious academic awards that an American student can receive. Michigan State University also is a prominent sponsor of National Merit Scholars.

MSU adds to the store of knowledge with a wide array of outstanding research activities that are supported by a multimillion dollar sponsor-funding program. Some major facilities include the Pesticide Research Center, which presents a model program of multidisciplinary research and teaching; the Plant Research Laboratory, operated with the U.S. Department of Energy as a national plant biology center; and the MSU/W. K. Kellogg Biological Station, which has been designated as a National Research Preserve. In collaboration with both the National Science Foundation and the U.S. Department of Energy, the National Superconducting Cyclotron Laboratory at MSU is examining the nuclei of the heaviest of elements.

Benefits of the university are brought to the public by the Agricultural Experiment Station, Lifelong Education Programs, and the Cooperative Extension Service. Their programs provide technical information and formal course work for many Michigan citizens. The Kellogg Center for Continuing Education, one of the finest conference centers in the nation, annually hosts nearly 60,000 adults who come to the campus for some 600 conferences and other educational meetings.

The university's land-grant concept of service is international. Supported by grants from the federal government and private foundations, MSU maintains research and educational assistance projects on a worldwide basis. International projects have given many faculty members overseas experience, adding a new dimension to their teaching.

Michigan State University is a member of the Association of American Universities, National Association of State Universities and Land-Grant Colleges, American Council on Education, American Council of Learned Societies, International Association of Universities, Association of Graduate Schools, Council of Graduate Schools, and the Committee on Institutional Cooperation.

HONORARY DEGREE

STEVLAND MORRIS (STEVIE WONDER)

As a musician and a humanitarian, you have set a new high standard of what can be accomplished when genius faces what many would regard as insuperable barriers. Your brilliant and honored career as a musician has been the foundation on which you have built a life as a philanthropist.

Blind from the time of your birth in Detroit, your musical gifts led you to fame as a twelve year-old genius even while you worked to complete the requirements for graduation from the Michigan School for the Blind in 1969. You have never been content merely to profit from a highly popular style developed while still very young. By the time you were 21 you were creatively engaged in successful experimentation with new instruments—including the emerging Moog and Arp synthesizers—and produced albums which, while focusing on musical growth rather than popular appeal, nevertheless led quickly to more records that spoke powerfully to the widest audiences. “People shouldn’t expect a set thing from me,” you said; “I love to grow.”

In 1973, a highway collision left you near death, but your characteristic will to overcome adversity aided your recovery, which was marked by an award for the Best Album of 1974. The mid-1970s were also marked by your Christmas concert at Madison Square Garden, the proceeds of which were donated to charities benefiting underprivileged children and the elderly. Since that time, your career has been dedicated equally to musical innovation and growth, and to philanthropic efforts on behalf of a wide range of causes.

You have founded the Stevie Wonder Home for Blind and Retarded Children. You were instrumental in the creation of the *We are the World* album to fight world hunger, “That’s What Friends are For” to support AIDS research, and “Don’t Drive Drunk,” as part of the campaign against alcohol. You appeared on a poster distributed to 16,000 high schools to discourage drunk driving. And your song “It’s Wrong” speaks out against apartheid. The album with which you entered the 1980s, *Hotter Than July*, was dedicated to Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and in 1981 and 1982 you sponsored two marches in Washington, D.C. to respectfully demand that the United States Congress declare Dr. King’s birthday, January 15th, a national holiday. In 1984, you again returned to Washington to celebrate the passage of that bill.

You have been especially honored as a humanitarian and philanthropist at Washington, D.C.’s annual Human Kindness Day. And your brilliant musical accomplishment has earned you induction into the Songwriters Hall of Fame.

Electronic technology is now the focus of your interests. A pioneer in the use of synthesizers, you have also used computers innovatively in the service of music, both in the studio and on the concert stage. To use your own words, electronic sounds are “like different paints a painter might use to create a picture, an expression. Only what I’m making is a sound expression, a painting that the ear can see.”

Your image—a painting that the ear can see—is a triumphant statement of your own capacity to imagine the impossible, and your determination to do it. Your life and your values show that the most insuperable obstacles can be challenges to great accomplishment and can lead to profound awareness of shared humanity in our diversity. You inspire this University and all of us toward our goal. Michigan State University pays tribute to your accomplishment and your tireless encouragement of human connection by awarding you the honorary degree of Doctor of Humanities.
