MISSION STATEMENT

Michigan State University, a member of the Association of American Universities and one of the top 100 research universities in the world, was founded in 1855. We are an inclusive, academic community known for our traditionally strong academic disciplines and professional programs, and our liberal arts foundation. Our cross- and interdisciplinary enterprises connect the sciences, humanities, and professions in practical, sustainable, and innovative ways to address society's rapidly changing needs.

As a public, research-intensive, land-grant university funded in part by the state of Michigan, our mission is to advance knowledge and transform lives by:

- providing outstanding undergraduate, graduate, and professional education to promising, qualified students in order to prepare them to contribute fully to society as globally engaged citizen leaders;
- conducting research of the highest caliber that seeks to answer questions and create solutions to expand human understanding and make a positive difference, both locally and globally;
- advancing outreach, engagement, and economic development activities that are innovative, research-driven, and lead to a better quality of life for individuals and communities, at home and around the world.



UNIVERSITY MACE

Michigan State University is pleased to include the University mace in commencement ceremonies. The introduction of the mace, at the 2005 Founders' Day celebration and inauguration of MSU's twentieth president, serves to commemorate the sesquicentennial celebration. The University, founded in 1855, celebrated its 150th birthday in 2005. The mace was designed by University Relations and produced by Physical Plant staff.

Historically, the mace is a symbol of authority dating from medieval times when knights carried them during processions with their kings. As the tradition grew, the mace became a ceremonial symbol of peaceful leadership, and maces were embellished with jewels and metals. Today, a university's mace is carried before the president or chancellor and platform-party dignitaries at commencement, inaugural, and other academic ceremonial processions.

The Michigan State University mace, 42 inches in length, includes important institutional symbols in its finial, crown, and shaft. The finial depicts the circular University seal, which includes an image of "Old College Hall." This oak-carved seal derives from an 1869 State Board of Agriculture (now, Board of Trustees) authorization for a woodcut to be used as the frontispiece of the college academic catalog. College Hall, built in 1856, was the first instructional building erected in the United States for the teaching of scientific agriculture. When it collapsed in 1918, John Beaumont (class of 1882) provided funds to erect Beaumont Tower in 1928 at the same location. The tower stands as a symbol of Michigan State's beginnings as the first land-grant college dedicated to teaching "agriculture and the mechanic arts" with a "liberal and practical curriculum."



The mace's crown is trimmed with a maple samara and acorn pattern carved from walnut, a pattern drawn from the "Michigan State College" limestone relief at the Abbot Road and other campus entrances. An image of Beaumont Tower lies in the crown's oak center.

Below the crown is the cylindrical shaft, whose alternating, horizontal oak and walnut bands descend to a brass tip. Its oak is purported to be "Beaumont oak," that is, from one of the original saplings surrounding College Hall. Its walnut is from a tree removed to clear land for the Wharton Center for Performing Arts in 1982.

In its soaring verticality, Beaumont Tower continues to inspire the MSU community and is an appropriate symbol for the MSU mace. As President Robert S. Shaw (1928–41) stated at the tower's dedication, it has served as "a unifying factor" to remind us, even through our individual activities, of the overall mission of Michigan State University to inspire us by "appealing to many of the better things in us" and to encourage us to "live up to higher standards, scholastically, socially, morally, and spiritually in all of our affairs."

MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY

Michigan State University, founded in 1855, is a leader in realizing the ideal of democratizing education and knowledge. Officially named the Agricultural College of the State of Michigan, it became the model for all land-grant institutions established by the Morrill Act, passed by Congress in 1862. The research and knowledge developed at land-grant institutions provides practical solutions that make a difference in the lives of individuals and in communities. Now, as a major public research university with global reach, Michigan State University continues this tradition with its commitment to advancing knowledge and transforming lives across the state, the region, and around the world.

From its beginnings on the site where Beaumont Tower now stands, the East Lansing campus has grown from 677 to 5,200 acres, and from three to 561 buildings. Today, 15,000 acres are used throughout Michigan for agricultural, animal, and forestry research.

MSU has more than 47,000 students from all 83 counties in Michigan, all 50 states, and 130 other countries. Nearly 500,000 Spartan alumni live around the globe.

Since its agricultural beginnings, MSU has grown to 17 degree-granting colleges offering more than 200 programs of study, and is the only university in the country with three on-campus medical schools.

The Honors College attracts academically talented scholars and enables these students to pursue individualized, enriched programs of study. MSU has produced more Rhodes Scholars in the past 25 years than any other Big Ten school.

Research and other grants total nearly \$500 million a year. The top federal funding agencies include the National Science Foundation, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, and the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Other externally funded research programs include the MSU–U.S. Department of Energy Plant Research Laboratory, the Center for Advancing Microbial Risk Assessment, the Great Lakes Bioenergy Research Center, the Energy and Automotive Research Laboratories, the Composite Vehicle Research Center, the U.S.–China Center for Research on Educational Excellence, the Center for Advanced Study of International Development, and the Center for International Business Education and Research.

The National Superconducting Cyclotron Laboratory is the premier rare isotope research facility in the nation. In December 2008, the U.S. Department of Energy selected MSU to design and establish the Facility for Rare Isotope Beams (FRIB). The proposed \$600 million facility will bring together an international community of leading scientists. Their work will help unlock the mysteries of the universe and promote breakthrough applications for medicine, national security, and the environment.

MSU Extension reaches into all 83 counties in Michigan to provide practical, university-based knowledge. The AgBioResearch (formerly Michigan Agricultural Experiment Station) encompasses the research of more than 400 scientists in six colleges and at a network of 14 field research stations in the state. Their work ranges from the development of forest products to food safety, new varieties of fruits and vegetables, water quality, livestock production, rural and community development, and the quality of life of Michigan youth and families.

University Outreach and Engagement connects faculty with external audiences and constituencies to address community issues through research and collaboration. MSU Global extends academic and professional degree and certificate programs to off-campus learners.

MSU is a national leader in study abroad among U.S. public universities with more than 270 programs on all continents in more than 60 countries. Nearly 3,000 MSU students participate in study abroad each year.

Michigan State University is a member of the Association of American Universities, the Association of Public and Land-grant Universities, the American Council on Education, the American Council of Learned Societies, the International Association of Universities, the Association of Graduate Schools, the Council of Graduate Schools, and the Committee on Institutional Cooperation.

ACADEMIC ATTIRE

In 1895, the Intercollegiate Commission, a group of leading American educators, introduced an academic costume code which by design of gowns and hoods would indicate the various degrees, and which by colors would identify the various faculties.

Three types of gowns are indicated by the code. Those worn by the bachelors have long, pointed sleeves. Those worn by masters have long, closed sleeves with the arc of a circle near the bottom. Doctoral gowns are faced with velvet. The sleeves are full, round, and open with three bars of velvet on each sleeve. The velvet facing of the bars on the sleeves may be black or the same color as the binding of the hood.

Hoods are made of material identical with the gown and are lined in the official academic color of the institution conferring the degree (e.g., green and white for MSU). If the institution has more than one color, the chevron is used to introduce the second color. Colored velvet or velveteen binds the hoods and indicates the department of faculty to which the degree pertains.

The color of the velvet of the hood is distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture should be maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. Generally, the code for the velvet of the hood is the same as listed for tassels.

At Michigan State University, it is customary to identify the candidates graduating from the different areas of study by tassels of the official color as established by the Intercollegiate Code. Candidates graduating from the Honors College wear a white stole with the initials "HC." Candidates graduating "With Honor" or "With High Honor" wear a gold braid.

HONORARY DEGREE CITATIONS

MITCHEL D. ALBOM

As a nationally acclaimed sports journalist at the *Detroit Free Press*, you are one of the best-known media figures in the city's history, working in newspapers, radio, and television. In fact, you are one of the most award-winning sports writers of your era.

You are also an internationally renowned, best-selling author, journalist, screenwriter, playwright, radio and television broadcaster and musician. Your inspirational books—*Tuesdays with Morrie*, *The Five People You Meet in Heaven*, *For One More Day*, and *Have a Little Faith*—have motivated people around the globe. These books collectively have sold more than 28 million copies worldwide, been published in 41 territories and in 42 languages, and been made into Emmy Award-winning and critically acclaimed television movies.

You have founded several charities, many in the metropolitan Detroit area, including The Dream Fund, which provides funding for

under-served children to participate in the arts; A Time To Help, which encourages the people of Detroit to volunteer for building houses, delivering meals, and packing food; S.A.Y. Detroit, "Super All Year," an umbrella charity organization, dedicated to improving the lives of the neediest, which includes the S.A.Y. Detroit Family Health Clinic; and A Hole in the Roof Foundation, which helps faith groups of every denomination who care for the homeless.

You also support the Have Faith Haiti Mission, which is dedicated to the safety, education, health, and spiritual development of Haiti's impoverished children and orphans.

For lending your time, extraordinary talent, and considerable influence to bring entertainment and inspiration to millions and hope to the most desperate among us, I am pleased to award you the honorary degree Doctor of Humanities from Michigan State University.



DAVID D. ARNOLD

You are a leader in education, administration, philanthropy, international development, and governance practice, recognized for your global networking skills and international alliance-building in Asia and the Middle East. Under your direction, The Asia Foundation pursues its mission to promote the rule of law; advance human rights; empower women; reform economic policy; and advance prosperity, justice and peace in Asia.

A Michigan native, you began your public service career here upon completion of your Master of Public Administration at Michigan State University. At the Institute of International Education, you worked to foster mutual understanding, strengthen the international competence of U.S. citizens, and build global problem-solving capabilities and institutional capacity worldwide. At the Ford Foundation, you served as the first program officer in the field of governance and as its representative in India, Nepal, and Sri Lanka.

You have promoted open discourse with the Middle East and have stressed the importance

of higher education in the region, holding firm the belief that higher education is the key to the future of a region, where the real wealth of nations will not be measured in barrels of oil, but in the capacity of succeeding generations to meet economic and social challenges of a changing geopolitical environment.

As president of The American University in Cairo, you oversaw a \$400-million campus expansion, led a \$125-million fundraising campaign, and launched numerous new academic programs. You cultivated collaborative partnerships to benefit students directly through new scholarship opportunities funded by private donors, the United States Agency for International Development, and the State Department's Middle East Partnership Initiative.

For your commitment to advancing human rights through international partnerships and using the power of education to advance social and economic progress, I am pleased to award you the honorary degree of Doctor of Humanities from Michigan State University.



HONORARY DEGREE CITATIONS

EMILIO F. MORAN

You are an internationally recognized expert in the field of environmental anthropology, tropical ecology, and the human dimensions of global environmental change, whose theories inform our understanding of how the human species perceives and interacts with its physical environment.

For more than 30 years, you have studied land use change in the Amazon Basin, and have conducted similar projects in Venezuela, Peru, Costa Rica, Mexico, and the Cape Verde Islands in West Africa. You are one of a few anthropologists worldwide who has addressed the importance of the human dimensions of global environmental change. Your research into the human causes and consequences of environmental change debunked long-standing myths about human interaction with the environment.

You are widely recognized as one of the first social scientists to integrate the use of satellite remote sensing and geographic information systems into anthropological research. By adding innovative technologies to traditional research methodologies, you have provided vital insights into the dynamics of human-environment interactions.

You are editor of a book series, *Human-Environment Interactions*, and author of six books, ten edited volumes, and more than 125 journal articles and book chapters, including *Through Amazonian Eyes: The Human Ecology of Amazonian Populations*, which has been translated to Spanish and Portuguese.

At Indiana University Bloomington, you are a Distinguished Professor, the Rudy Professor of Anthropology, and a professor of environmental sciences, founding co-director of the Center for the Study of Institutions, Population and Environmental Change, and director of the Anthropological Center for Training and Research on Global Environmental Change. You have received many prestigious honors including election to the National Academy of Sciences and being named a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science.

For your exemplary contributions to scholarship and education, I am pleased to award you the honorary degree Doctor of Science from Michigan State University.



MARGARET ANN "RANNY" RIECKER
You are a generous humanitarian and civic leader, the head of one of the largest foundations in Michigan, the Herbert H. and Grace A. Dow Foundation. The Foundation, which was established in 1936 in memory of your grandfather, founder of The Dow Chemical Company, improves the educational, religious, economic, and cultural lives of the people of Michigan.

You also serve as chair of the Harry A. and Margaret D. Towsley Foundation, named for your parents. These foundations have awarded more than \$500 million dollars for projects that range from providing health and human services in Midland, Michigan, to conserving 271,000 acres of land in Michigan's Upper Peninsula.

You are a committed supporter of higher education through your role in these foundations and in your personal volunteer efforts. At Michigan State University, you helped establish the Dow Institute for Materials Research, the Herbert H. and Grace A. Dow Foundation Endowed Fund for Pediatric Training, the Harry

A. and Margaret D. Towsley Endowment for Geriatric Training, and the Pediatric Simulation Unit and the Geriatric Simulation Unit, the latter two at MSU's Secchia Center in Grand Rapids.

Your ability to collaborate and build long-term, productive relationships uniquely positioned you to become one of the founding members of the Council of Michigan Foundations, an association of grant-making organizations working together to strengthen, promote, and increase philanthropy in Michigan. You also serve on boards of directors for Midland Tomorrow, the Michigan Molecular Institute, North Coast Technology Investors, and other local organizations dedicated to enhancing the quality of life and business environment.

For your accomplishments, which build on your family's legacy of progressive, dedicated women, and for your devotion to the betterment of others through your leadership and inspiration, I am pleased to award you the honorary degree of Doctor of Humanities from Michigan State University.



HONORARY DEGREE CITATIONS

ROY S. ROBERTS

As a leader who has had an extraordinary career in business and public service, most recently you assumed the challenging role as emergency manager of the Detroit Public Schools.

As group vice president for North American Vehicle Sales for General Motors Corporation, you achieved the distinction of being the highest ranking African American executive in the U.S. automobile industry. You began your long career path working on the assembly line at GM while you attended college full-time at night to earn your bachelor's degree. Along that path, you developed a reputation as a tough, but compassionate, leader who streamlined operations without resorting to the massive, morale-breaking layoffs so common in the auto industry during the last few decades. You committed yourself to contributing something meaningful to each assignment—from being a plant manager to being a vice president.

You have succeeded in fulfillment of significant civic and social responsibilities in your roles

with the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, the Boy Scouts of America, the National Urban League, and many other community organizations, and have been generous in your support of the Detroit Institute of Arts.

As one who benefited from a public education, along with your wife, four children, and six grandsons, you are well-positioned to bring the same sense of value and purpose to your newest challenge in the Detroit Public Schools. Under your leadership, the district has already eliminated about \$200 million dollars from its deficit by refinancing short-term notes, and it has participated in the initial phase of the innovative Michigan Education Achievement System.

For your courage and wisdom in accepting challenges of leadership in business and education in a radically changing social and economic environment, I am pleased to award you the honorary degree Doctor of Business from Michigan State University.




BACCALAUREATE DEGREES

HONORS

The University acknowledges candidates for the bachelor's degree who will graduate as Academic Scholars (A), from the Honors College (H), With Honor (*), or With High Honor (**). Academic Scholars completed a two-year honors program including at least four honors-caliber courses. Honors College graduates are academically talented students who have participated in rigorous, highly individualized programs of study, including at least eight honors-caliber courses.

Graduation Honors: the current minimum grade point average for seniors graduating With Honor is 3.68 and those graduating With High Honor is 3.88 (which is approximately 20 percent of graduating seniors who have earned the highest grade point averages). Recognition of graduation honors in the commencement program is based on the grade point average of all work at MSU completed prior to the opening of the semester of graduation. To be eligible for graduation honors, transfer students must earn a minimum of 50 semester credits at MSU.


