# DEDICATION OF THE ALUMNI MEMORIAL CHAPEL



Michigan State College Two o'clock in the afternoon June 7, 1952

THE ALUMNI OF MICHIGAN STATE COLLEGE considered various ways and forms of preserving the memory of the service of thousands of boys and girls who went forth from this campus to serve in the wars in defense of America.

Sixty-eight hundred of Michigan States' former students filled the role of our nation's defenders, and chose to crusade for personal and national ideals through warfare. Of this number, four hundred and twenty-seven never returned to campus scenes again.

Because the central theme of the sacrifices of these young people was FAITH—faith in the dignity of man, faith in democracy, faith in human freedoms, faith in the sacredness of family ties—this enduring memorial was chosen and dedicated to faith—all faiths.

The highest form of dedication is to the spirit—a supreme power. This dictated the choice of a shrine to immortalize these lives.

In creating this memorial we have received over thirty gracious gifts from pastors of European cathedrals who have sent us stones taken from churches, some of which are over five hundred years old. These stones were principally from bombed houses of worship. We are indeed grateful for these expressions of brotherhood from the older civilizations to us.

We are grateful, too, for the gifts of nearly forty-five hundred Spartans who have made this shrine possible.

May we never be lacking in the faith that was theirs.
