

Typical Quonset Hut Layout Scale -- 1" = 10'






Typical 2-Bed Room Apartment. Scale--1" = 10'

SUBJECT: Children Playing in the Street

TO: Occupants of M.S.C. Trailers - Especially Parents

Vehicular traffic in and out of the Trailers is heavy and will continue to be heavy until completion of the project. The speed limit, as posted at entrance of Trailers, is 10 Miles Per Hour. This speed is not maintained by all vehicles. The greatest offenders are trucks and automobiles driven by people living outside the Trailers. However, many of our Trailer occupants, even parents, do not observe the 10 Miles Per Hour limit.

At present we have 90 children in the Trailers, most of whom are less than 4 years of age, and therefore, not cognizant of the danger of playing in or near the roadway.

Enclosed play yards, with sand boxes, have been constructed in each section throughout the entire area. These were constructed primarily for children of pre-school age; tp keep them close to home and away from the danger always present when small children play near a heavily travelled road. It is true there is no shade in many of the play yards. It is also true that there is no shade in or near the roadway.

We have had no accidents involving children, but each and every family should be ever alert to the dangers involved in driving through the area or permitting their children to play near the roadway.

Subject: Rubbish Collection

In order to facilitate the collection of rubbish and garbage throughout the campus which, of course, includes the Faculty Housing Area, the following change in procedure is being announced, effective Thursday A.M. November 7.

- 1. The garbage and rubbish can should be placed on the sidewalk in front of each house by 8 A.M. on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday of each week.
- . 2. Rubbish that will not go in the can should be placed in some other container, such as a cardboard box, basket etc., to prevent it from being blown about and cluttering up the areas.
- 3. All empty containers should be taken from the sidewalk and placed at the rear of each house by 12 noon of the day of collection.

This method will also prevent the possibility of the collector taking some item that has been placed temporarily at the back door.
