The purposes of introducing modern art of our homeland are to cause to understand the cultural level of our homeland and to feel with the natural features of Okinawa at present through these art works.

At present, an art movement is very active in Okinawa: the "Okiten" is held in every spring and the arts festival comprising dances, musics, plays, etc. is an autumn.

The painting and calligraphical works to be exhibited in Hawaii are those produced by the Examiners of the "Okiten" in which almost all artists and calligraphers of Okinawa are participated. In this sense, it is not too much to say that they are the paramount painting and calligraphical works in Okinawa.

Further, the "Okiten" Management Committee has extended their positive and immeasurable assistances for planning and preparation of this exhibition, for which I hereby express my sincere gratitude.

MESSAGE

By Ryoken Toyohira, Chairman of the "Okiten" Management Committee

I am with great pleasure to learn that an exhibition of the pick of the exhibits at the "Okiten" which is a sole general fine arts exhibition in Okinawa is to be held, through the arrangements of the Government of the Ryukyu Islands, in Hawaii with which the Okinawan people is most closely connected.

The ancient cultural properties of Okinawa were already introduced to foreign countries for several times but this is the first time for the works of the contemporary Okinawan artists. Therefore, the exhibitors, the parties concerned and all the Ryukyuan people take a special interest in this exhibition.

As you know, the Okinawan culture was completely destroyed by the World War II so much as almost nothing remained. The proverb says, "A state may be ruined, yet its mountains and rivers will remain as they were." This proverb represents the wretchedness of a defeated country. However, as for Okinawa, even mountains and rivers changed. The life of Okinawan people immediately after the war termination was not much different from the primitive life two or three thousand years ago.

Fortunately, however, with great assistances from the United States authorities, Okinawan descendants residing in Hawaii and in Japan, the economic life of the people has been recovering step by step and, at present, the development achieved is even above the pre-war level in some aspects.

However, the moral civilization or culture such as art and scholarly attainments are not to be done in a day.

If the Okinawan people, or their blood, is without a higher cultural quality inherited from their ancestors, it has not been able to restore and further enrich their conventional culture even though they have become rich materially.

The "Okiten" held its first exhibition in spring of 1949 when the traces of war devastation was still fresh, under the sponsorship of the Okinawa Times. The exhibition-hall was quonset huts disposed of from the U.S. Armed Forces and used by the Okinawa Times as its office building. The participated painters painted on *Mesnite* boards which had been used as an inner wall for quonset huts, with the paints obtained by barter.

The exhibition was really poor one comparing with those held recently, but it was whole-heartedly welcomed and accepted by those who were sustaining the desolate and dreary life at that time, as if a rainfall eagerly longer for.

Further, this exhibition improved very much the understandings toward the Okinawan people of the American people who were only understanding the life of the Okinawan people rather than that of the natives of the South Sea Islands.

For ten years and more since then, the Okiten has grown up year by year by adding and including those branches of handicrafts, photographs and calligraphy, and it has been developed to such an extent as was given applause by Mrs. Elise Greeley, an American art critic, who visited Okinawa last year, saying: "I couldn't expect such a grand exhibition in a small island like this."

Most of the Okiten exhibitors are those whose works were admitted to the exhibitions in Tokyo and some of them won a prize selected from among many exhibitors from every and all parts of Japan.

The exhibition to be held in Hawaii is composed chiefly of the works of these excellent artists. I believe some one among them may push into the American or European world of art in the future and leave his mark on the world art history.

The pedestal of a bronze statute erected at a park in Washington City in memory of the distinguished services of the U. S. Marine Corps bears the letters "Okinawa" carved together with many other islands where a battle was fought.

The "Okinawa" is strongly kept in the minds of the American people as a battlefield where many of their fathers, brothers and sons were killed but they know almost nothing about the present conditions of the firmly-rooted and vivid Okinawan culture which took wing from the ruins like a phenix.

I sincerely hope that you will reperceive the Okinawan culture through this exhibition and give your kind cooperation for its development in the future.

然し、芸術や学問のような精神的な文化は一朝一夕で作られるものではありません。 もし沖縄に、沖縄の人々の血の中に、祖先から受け継がれて来た高い文化的な素質が無 かつたならば、如何に物質的に豊かになつても、それを生かして伝統的な文化を回復し、 更に豊かに発展させることは出来なかつたでしよう。

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会場は、当時米軍払い下げのコンセツトの社屋を使用し、出品した画家達は、コンセツ トの壁などに使われていたメスナイトの板をカンバス代りに使用し、物々交換で手に入れ た絵具で制作しました。

今から見れば実に登弱な展覧会でしたが、当時さくばくとした生活にあえいでいた人々 から早天の慈雨のような喜びで迎えられました。

又、その頃、南洋の土人以下の沖縄人の生活しか知らぬアメリカ人の認識を大いに改め させました。

以来十余年、沖展は工芸、写真、書道の諸部門を加えて、年々成長し、先年来島したア メリカの美術評論家ェリゼ・グリリー女史をして、「こんな小さな島に、こんな大きな展 覧会があるのか」と賞嘆させるまでに至つています。

又沖展出品者の殆んどが東京の展覧会に入選し、その内の何人かは日本全国の数多くの 出品者の中から選ばれて、受賞の栄冠を獲得しています。

今度ハワイで展示される作品は、この様な優秀な美術家の作品を中心として蒐められて います。

今後、この美術家達の中からアメリカやヨーロツパに進出して、世界の美術史に名を残 す人々も必ず出て来ると信じます。

ワシントン市の公園にある米国海兵隊の戦功を記念した銅像の台座には、戦場となつた 多くの島の名と共に「沖縄」の文字が刻みてまれています。

アメリカ人にとつて、沖縄は彼等の多くの肉身を失つた戰場として、人々の心に深く刻 みこまれている場所ですが、あの廃虚の中からフェニックスのように飛び立つた、根強く そして発らつとした沖縄文化の現狀は殆んど知られておりません。

どうかこの展覧会を機会として沖縄文化を再認識され、今後の発展に御協力下さること を切望してやみません。



此の度、琉球政府の尽力で、沖縄唯一の総合美術展覧会ー沖展の選抜展を、私達沖縄の 人々にとつて最も縁の深いハワイで開くことになりました。 沖縄の古い文化財は、今迄にも幾度か海外に紹介されたことがありますが、現代の美術 家達の作品が紹介されるのは今回が始めてであります。 それだけに出品者並びに関係者、ひいては沖縄全住民の関心は非常に深いものがありま す。

御承知のように、沖縄の文化は今次大戦に於て、一物も残さぬほど徹底的に破壊しつく されました。

「国敗れて山河あり」とは、敗北した国の哀れさを示した諺ですが、沖縄は山河さえも あらたまつたのです。戦火がおさまつた当時の人々の生活は、二三千年前の原始時代その ものでした。

幸い当時の米国当局、ハワイや米本土に在住される沖縄出身の方々の厚い御援助で経済 生活は次第に回復の途をたどり、今日、ある面では、戦前以上の水準を示しています。
