The UCM EXPERIMENTAL UNIVERSITY offers a series of Depth Education Groups, Cadres, and Encounter Groups which attempt to break through the institution's dehumanized, authority-oriented style of education. The groups work with an educational model which is built on entirely different presuppositions about learning.

- Learning is best accomplished in small groups where there is dialogue among the participants.
- Education should be problem-centered. It should begin with analysis of a specific problem and model-building and strategizing toward a solution and should culminate in action.
- Education should include a critical examination of our presuppositions about the problem.
- Education must take into account both the past and the future.
