Mrs. C. H. Alvord Dies in Virginia

Word was received today of the sudden death of Mrs. Lottie Hicks Alvord, 75, native of Reading and former resident of Hillsdale county, who passed away Thursday night at her home in Arlington, Va. She had been in poor health for several years, suffering from a heart ailment.

Mrs. Alvord was born June 20, 1872, in Reading, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Orlando Hicks. She was married at Hudson in October, 1896, to Charles H. Alvord, member of a prominent Hillsdale county family. His father, Nathan Alvord, was a former mayor of the city of Hillsdale, and he served at one time as a member of the Michigan state legislature.

Mr. and Mrs. Alvord resided on the Alvord farm in Camden before going south, residing first in Texas, and for the past several years in Arlington, Va.

Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. A. J. Weaver, Alexandria, Va.; Mrs. F. J. Konecny, Austin, Texas, and Mrs. Jack Williams, San Marcos, Texas; one son, Charles, Jr., of Arlington, Va.; and seven grandchildren. Mrs. Howard Bush, a niece residents in Montpelier, O.

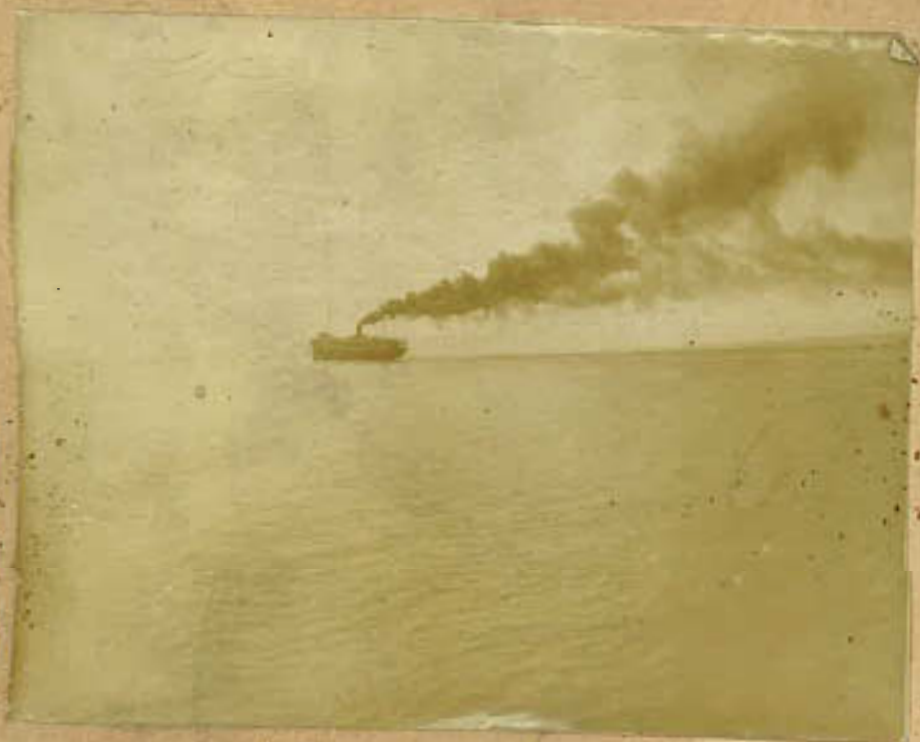
Funeral services will be held in Arlington.

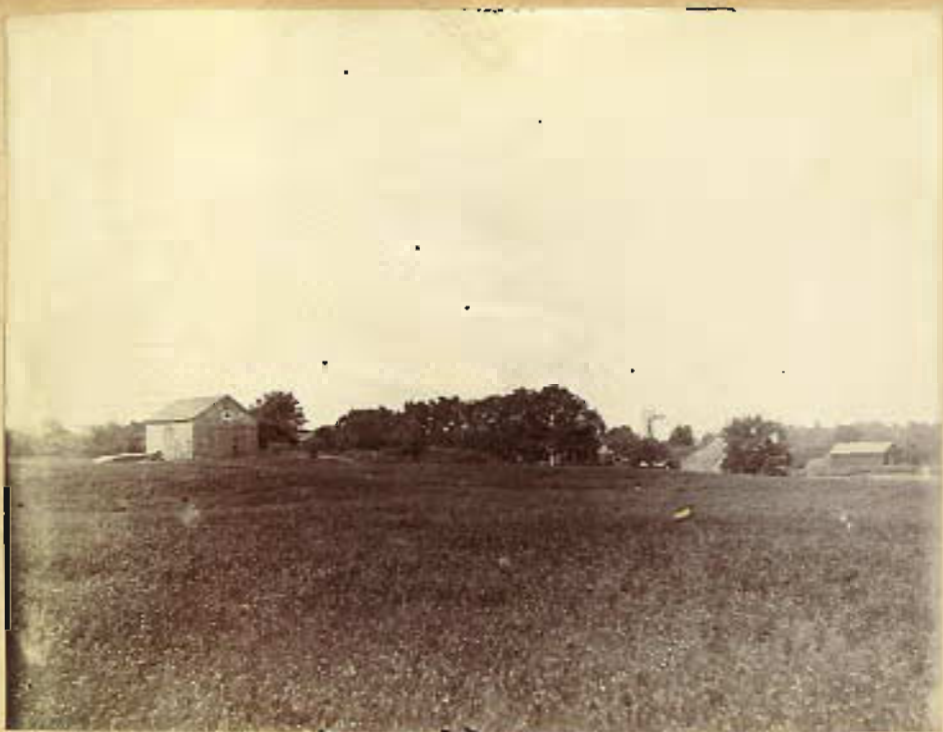

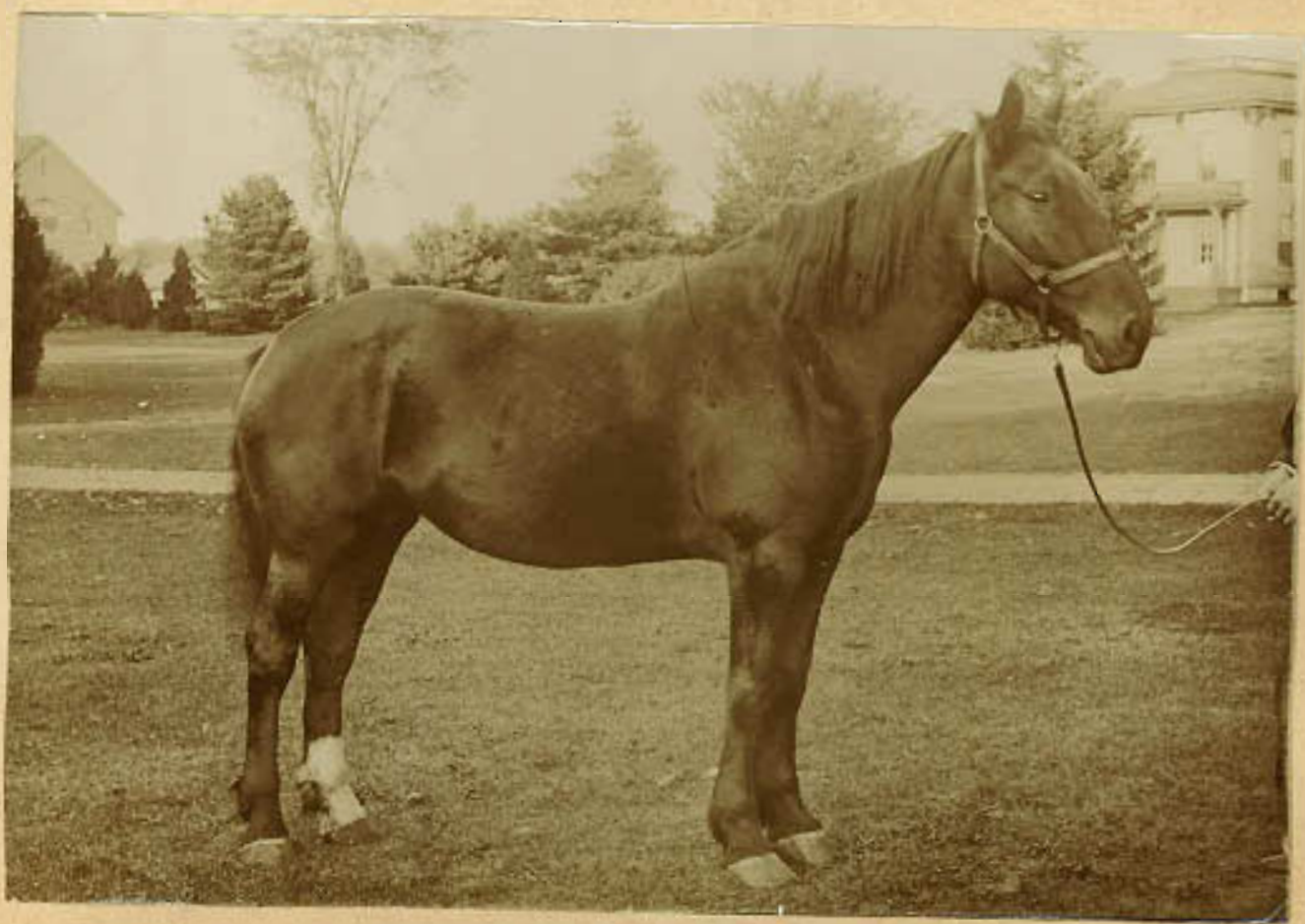
