The referee may stop a bout at any stage and make a decision if he considers it too one-sided.

GENERAL INFORMATION: A correct attitude on the part of spectators during a boxing meet can do much toward developing good sportsmanship, both in and out of the ring. In fairness to the contestants, silence must be maintained during each round. This silence, in addition to its many advantages of fairness, also enables the Referee to be heard without difficulty by the boxers. The proper time for applause is between rounds and bouts.
